Prior to studying the organ, Matthew excelled in piano, performing with three symphony orchestras before the age of eighteen, and winning numerous state and regional competitions throughout the north-west and southern United States.

While in the UK, Matthew looks forward to recitals in Chichester and St David's Cathedrals, and in Washington National Cathedral on his return to the USA.
