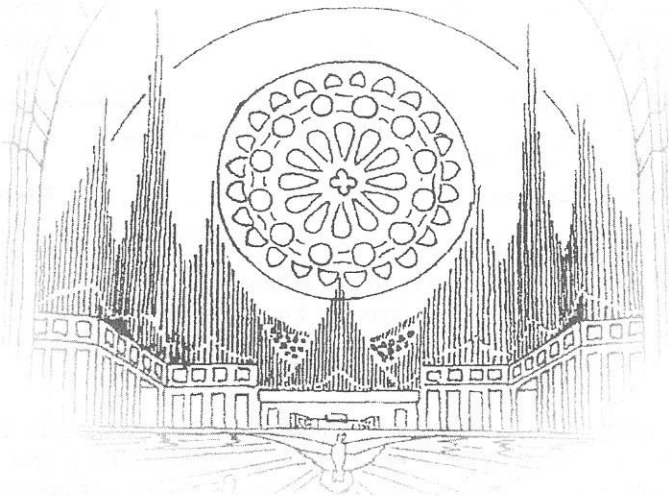

**Matthew Middleton** studied organ performance with Dr. Frank Speller at the University of Texas at Austin (note that of the last three composers on his program, he studied with Speller, the only American student of Demessieux, who was a pupil of Dupré). In response to his Junior Organ Recital, he was awarded the first Perfect Grade given to an organ student in over 35 years. After serving as organist at First Presbyterian Church and First United Methodist Church, Wichita Falls, Texas, and Hope Presbyterian Church, Austin, in September of last year he moved to England to take up joint positions of Organ Scholar at Bristol Cathedral and the magnificent Church of St Mary Redcliffe, Bristol. At the end of this month, Matthew will volunteer one year of service with the Presbyterian Church (USA), serving as organist and music teacher in Cairo, Egypt.
